



\$500,000. Infiltration Catchments. Hamilton and Kearny counties. Upper Arkansas River. Infiltration catchments will capture runoff water from ag lands before flowing into the Upper Arkansas River allowing it to infiltrate into the groundwater to combat the outward spread of saline water in the Arkansas River. At the same time, encouraging healthy soils can also increase infiltration with soil biology and structure before running off. One option, miles of vegetative berms maybe necessary to counter the salinity migration

Another option, to counter the loss to evaporation, Hickenbottom drains to move water from the surface past the less permeable layers of soil and root zone into the more permeable zones below. This will be a pilot and will require monitoring to measure the amounts of pollutants both in the caught water and in the groundwater nearby. Potentially, catchment basins in pivot corners, 20 feet deep, 3-4 surface acres, every 160 acres or 640 acres, Hickenbottom drains in catchments and groundwater monitoring wells. Illustration below.



Geotechnical and engineering study would be necessary to determine the feasibility and estimated cost of such a project. Pilot projects would support proof of concept.

Information Presentation

Internship Opportunities at GMD3 - Joscelyn Monarrez

Trevor Ahring noted that GMD3 is anticipating the budget for an intern next summer, which will be opened to applicants soon. He introduced Joscelyn Monarrez, who has been an intern with GMD3. Joscelyn reflected on her three-year internship, sharing how she started with little knowledge of water management but gained experience and confidence over time. She worked on many projects, including water use analysis, GIS mapping, conservation planning and grant proposals. The internship has helped her grow in technical skills and communication through public speaking. The three years have been instrumental in building her resume and professional network, which she believes will help her when applying for future jobs. She has grown in confidence, willingness to learn and gained more ease in stepping out of her comfort zone.

Old Business

Status of Tamarisk Removal Grant

The Tamarisk Removal Grant is being reviewed this afternoon by Build Kansas. However, the grant being reviewed to match it is still frozen. Abe Lollar added that the removal is at a standstill currently, due to mechanical issues. However, projects are being lined up for 2026, including approximately 100–150 acres near the Colorado line. Seeding is underway on Midwest farms, and a meeting has been scheduled with Cimarron National Grasslands to address a severely infested area.

General Update on WaterSMART

Conservation Initiative. GMD3

Trevor Ahring spoke on the Conservation Initiative for GMD 3. He stated that goals will be presented at the next meeting. While specific goals for each region have not been finalized, they are expected to be aggressive. The legislative deadline is July 1st, 2026.
